



## **BASK-MRC Fellowship in Revision Knee Arthroplasty**

The Revision Knee Network steering committee, supported by BASK and NHS England, is offering surgeons with an interest in revision knee surgery a visiting fellowship to support their development.

### **The proposed fellowship should**

- Be one week-long (Sunday night – Friday afternoon)
- Be hosted jointly between two geographically linked Major Revision Centres in England
- Split the week between the two MRCs
- Be able to accommodate two visiting fellows concurrently
- Offer significant educational opportunities in revision knee surgery

### **To qualify for the fellowship candidates should**

- Be a member of BASK
- Be under 45 years of age or within 5 years of completing fellowship training
- Have a proven interest in revision knee arthroplasty
- Be prepared to make a presentation at the following year's MRC meeting

### **Financial support** will be available as follows

- £1000 per fellow to cover hotel accommodation, meals and travel (e.g. by rail)
- £500 to support a dinner at a host site

To host the fellowship applications are invited from MRCs in England. **The deadline for applications is Friday 31 October 2025.** To apply to become a host please submit

Applications for fellows will be by **CV and cover letter**. The application will be open between **1 December 2025 and 4 January 2026**.

Applications received from proposed hosting centres and fellows will be assessed by the revision knee steering committee.

The proposed dates for the 2026 visiting fellowship are Sunday 10 May – Friday 15 May 2026.
